Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County Touched By Tragedy

Memorial Services Planned For Faith Proctor

SPOKANE, WASHINGTON (Wednesday, January 4) – On January 1st, the Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County family lost one of its shining stars – Faith Proctor, 20, in the well-publicized and tragic car crash on Hwy 2.

As the 2010 Youth of the Year for the Boys & Girls Clubs of Spokane County, Proctor led by example. The youngest of four siblings, Proctor balanced a challenging school schedule, athletics and two part-time jobs in order to support her family. Surrounded by a neighborhood of violence and poverty, Proctor found strength and support at the Boys & Girls Club's Libby Teen Center. At only 20 years old, Proctor had just begun her journey and achieved her goal of attending WSU in order to study Special Education. Proctor made an indelible impact on the Club, her family and community; she will be greatly missed.

Faith Proctor's memorial service will be held at 11:00 am on Saturday, January 14th at Holy Temple Church of God in Christ, located at 806 W. Indiana. Open to the public, the burial procession will continue to the Fairmount Memorial Park (5200 W. Wellesley) immediately following.

The Faith Proctor Memorial Fund has been established at STCU and donations are now being accepted to help the family cover the costs of Faith's burial and memorial service.
