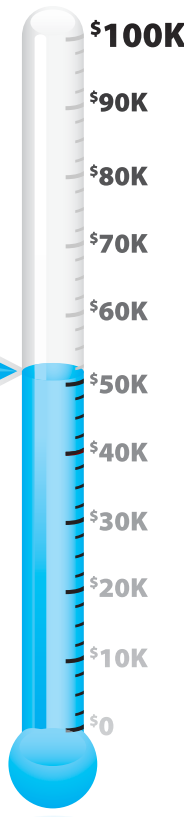

# High School Drop-Out Prevention Update

*Panhandle State Bank/Intermountain Community Bank Awards \$225,000 Over Five Years To High School Drop-Out Prevention Program*

After receiving an initial start-up grant of \$20,000 in 2009 from program sponsor Fred Meyer, and an additional \$10,000 grant from MetLife, Every Member, Every Year has gained momentum here in Spokane and helped leverage additional support and awareness. Targeted at reducing the County's high school drop-out rate of 30%, the Every Member, Every Year program has built success on the solid principles which focuses on three measurable goals: (1) every member is promoted every year to the next grade level, (2) every member graduates from high school and (3) every member is fully prepared to achieve real-world success in college, career and in life.

Last month we secured a major victory thanks to a five year, \$225,000 grant from Panhandle State Bank/Intermountain Community Bank. This funding will positively affect thousands of Spokane's most at-risk youth and help the organization expand and sustain intensive case management efforts to reduce the County's high school drop-out rate of 30%.

This increased financial support coupled with a strategic and implemented plan has also helped put the high school drop-out issue at the forefront of discussion thanks largely to growing public awareness. In the past two months, the Spokesman Review has run two articles about the program; one, a front page article on October 18th.

We would like to thank everyone involved with the Every Member, Every Year program: Fred Meyer, MetLife, the Inland Northwest Community Foundation, the Panhandle State Bank/Intermountain Community Bank, the Spokesman Review and all of the community members dedicated to ensuring our youth find success.
